Who is this course for?

These introductory qualifications are for anyone thinking about starting a career in Childcare. It would be beneficial (but not mandatory) if you had short-term access to work experience or a volunteer placement.

Course description

These qualifications help you develop the skills and knowledge you need to care for children. They cover areas such as:

- Communication between children aged 0 – 3 years and adults
- Communication skills with children
- Respecting children
- Keeping children safe
- Valuing children as individuals
- Encouraging children to eat healthily
- Physical activities for children
- Engaging children in a group activity.

How will I learn and be assessed?

You'll be assessed on a portfolio of evidence you build during the qualification. This evidence may be collected during practical assignments or projects or it may include observations and witness testimony from a work or volunteer placement.

What can I do after the course?

These qualifications provide pathways into the sector of Childcare for people new to Childcare or those returning to work after a break.

What other help will I get when taking up one of these courses?

Learners will get lots of support to prepare for work, complete CVs, write application forms and interview preparation. In addition, you can register with LLC's recruitment agency and will be able to apply for any suitable vacancies.
