Who is this course for?

These qualifications are aimed at anyone interested in or starting out in a career in adult social care or brushing up their skills in Health & Social Care and employability Skills.

Course Description

These qualifications allow you to acquire the knowledge of a number of essential areas of working in adult social care and include the following units:

- Principles of personal development in adult social care settings
- Principles of diversity, equality and inclusion in adult social care settings
- Principles of safeguarding and protection in health and social care
- Introduction to duty of care in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Understand the role of the Social Care Worker
- Understand person centered approaches in adult social care settings
- Understand health and safety in social care settings
- Understand how to handle information in social care settings

Assessments

To achieve the Level 2 Certificate in Preparing to Work in Adult Social Care (QCF) candidates will need to complete 20 credits from 9 mandatory units

The qualifications will be assessed by means of assignments, which are internally marked and then sent off to City & Guilds for externally assignments.

What can I do after the course?

These qualifications provide pathways into the sector of Adult Social Care for people new to adult social care or those returning to work after a break.

What other help will I get when taking up one of these courses?

Learners will get lots of support to prepare for work, complete CV's, write application forms, interview preparation. In addition, you can register with LLC's recruitment agency and will be able to apply for any suitable vacancies.
