Functional Skills Maths

Course Description

This is a Maths course which allows you to develop essential Maths skills including:

- Developing strategies for solving problems
- Applying maths to obtain answers to given practical problems
- Interpreting and communicating solutions to practical problems

This course is suitable for those who wish to develop their Maths skills.

Entry Requirements: - E2 – E3

None, but you will be assessed prior to starting the course to assess your current level.

Entry Requirements: - L1-L2

You will be assessed prior to starting the course and should be working at Entry 3 - Level 1 Maths, which means that you will have a good understanding of mathematical problems. It may be beneficial for some learners to take the Entry Level course first.

Assessment:

You will complete an online/paper-based Maths test, which will be externally marked and certificated by City & Guilds.

Teaching

Teaching will take place in a classroom environment in group sizes of 10 – 15 learners.

Duration

This course is run over 9 weeks with attendance 1 day per week.

Progression:

Having successfully achieved this qualification, the learner may wish to progress on to a next level Maths course.

You will need pen/pencil, a notepad and a folder to keep your work tidy.
